Even though the home's architecture seemed to insist on more than just a mere tribute to its Moorish ethos, the designer walked a very careful line between outright thematic interpretation and total stylistic departure. Yet in the intimacy of the VIP suite's master bath, the exoticism of the East was given full reign.

Combing the labyrinthine souks of Morocco, Ruderman found tiny antique lamps for an exquisite 19th-century vanity. A similar pierced metal chandelier hangs like a votive in one of many arched niches faced in antique diamond-shaped tiles. Most unique, she styled interlocking medallions made of laser-cut wood to fashion the walls.
