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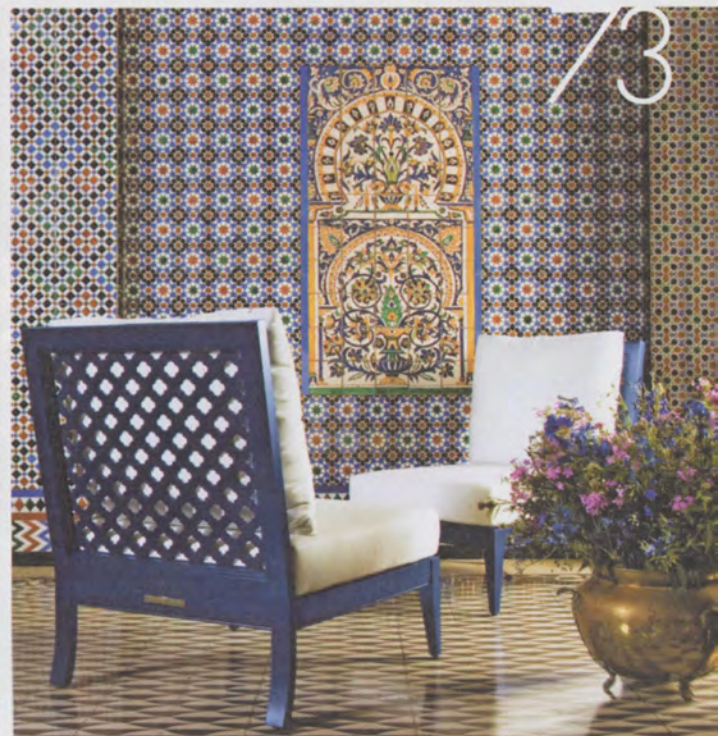

Southern Comfort

Nestled between stylish neighbors Mecox Gardens and Nobu, the pristine new showroom of Virginia-based couture garden furniture company **McKinnon and Harris** fits right in. Founded in 1991 by siblings William McKinnon Massie Jr. and Annie Harris Massie, the brand's first L.A. showroom (others are in New York City and London) will offer the La Cienega Design Quarter beautifully designed, handcrafted, made-to-order aluminum furniture of the highest quality. The company continues the bench built tradition, meaning each piece is made from start to finish on a craftsman's own workbench—a process ensuring flawlessness impossible to match on an assembly line—and is personally initialed and dated

by the person who created it. "Often in life there are ways to make something easier, although without the same outcome, and this is simply not the approach we take," explains William. "To make something extraordinary you cannot take shortcuts." Setting off the various styles and cultivated color palette (and lending an expansive gallery feel to the space) are the showroom's large skylights and all-white design scheme by architect Scott Natvig. "Southern California has such a specific light, and we really wanted to bring that wonderful local quality into the space," says William.
